

Missionary of the Week: Doug & Margaret Nichols (Philippines)

Dear Friend,

On Wednesday November 11, the devastating typhoon “Ulysses” hit the Philippines and left millions suffering from flood waters. Much of Manila is flooded with many houses and shacks completely under water with everything ruined! They have been hit by three typhoons in the last two weeks.

People are stranded on their rooftops. Many of these seniors and children have not been able to be out of their homes for nine months because of the pandemic lockdown. Governmental and church agencies are struggling to provide help and food at this time.

The Philippine government compares today's situation to the Typhoon Ondoy in 2009 where thousands lost their lives.

Our son Robby phoned saying he and family were okay, house not flooded but their ministry work vehicle destroyed. As soon as the flood waters subside, he needs to find transportation to deliver relief items of food, clothing, fresh water, and medicines to churches he has been working with, and whose pastors have lost everything!

How to pray and how to help? What is needed to begin? Possible \$10,000 for immediate relief and \$15,000 next week to help pastors rebuild.

Yes, this is a huge amount yet we want to help our brothers and sisters in any way we can.

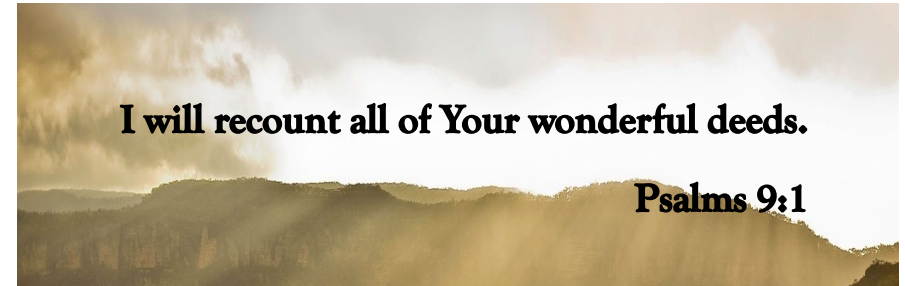
