Greetings KBC,

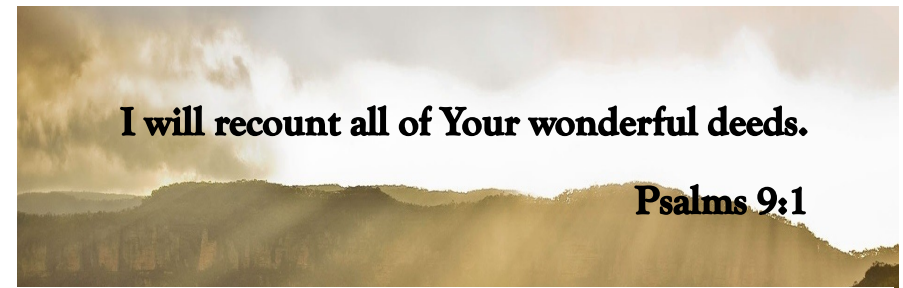
