Dear Keyport Bible Church,

I'm writing from my bed, self quarantined as I have a weird chest thing going on which may be COVID but I'm not paying a big fee just to be able to say that it is at least not unless I'm on death's door which does not appear to be the situation.

Either way I want to keep the kids and staff well, so I'm distancing and spending more time in the word.

Tomorrow we are scheduled to have a parent, teacher and administrator conference to discuss the progress of the three deaf girls and then the students will all have farming practicals the rest of the day. Awema will start up school on Monday with the others. Oh how I wish she could talk in words we could understand. She has plenty to say most days. Her sign language needs improvement so pray with us for that. I'm working on ways to get her more speaking and playing time with the other deaf students.

I rented a ten acre farm so we could grow our staples for next year and the girls need to have some basic knowledge of farming. We also purchased laying hens but have lost some so pray we don't lose any more.

I'm fasting from the news so only know that today was a sad day for many Americans. Time to reinforce our faith in God and His promises to us as children of the Most High God. I long for His return. Dreaming of my heavenly wedding gown and of walking on streets of pure God. It won't be long.

Thanks for your prayers. I'm hoping by February the adoptions will be final.
