Foster Care. Our foster son was with us for 6 months and then was placed back with his family. We've been in contact with them and are working to build a relationship to support and share the Gospel with them! It has been a bittersweet thing, but have seen the Lord growing and refining us through it.

Camp. Praise the Lord, we are running camp this summer! With lightened restrictions in Colorado and some modifications to how we do things, we've been able to set up a mask free camp experience very similar to previous summers! This was a huge answer to prayer. We are still struggling to fill all our staff needs, but the Lord is providing each week! Both our kids were able to attend camp as campers already this year. Last week our head cook had a medical emergency, so we are scrambling to cover the huge role she filled! It is doubtful that she will be able to work at camp again this summer. The other position we are struggling to fill is male counselors.

On Chase's front he is busy with lots of general handyman things while camp is running. He also continues to work on the second half of the boys bathhouse remodel when he has time. As we began to prepare for camp in May several large issues presented in the lodge. It is the biggest and oldest building Chase works to maintain. After asking several professionals for their opinions, Chase and Phil (the Director) presented the findings to the camp board. They have decided that due to the state of the building, the cost and time of remodeling the lodge is not a wise use of funds. The final decision was to tear down the lodge in the next couple years and replace it with a new building. While we know this is the best stewardship of time and money, it is an overwhelming task. Please pray for the board as they begin planning a new lodge building so that they can begin the fundraising for it!
