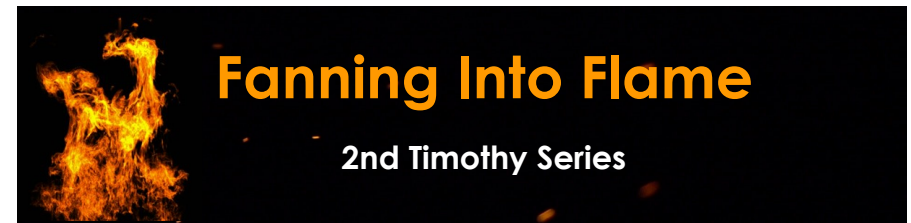
Together, we exist to mobilize, equip, care for, develop, and be workers who will magnify Jesus beautifully among Muslim people, wherever they are.
